We serve more than 65,000 children, adults and seniors across San Antonio. Nearly half of assisted households include children, and the median resident income is approximately \$12,000 per year. While housing is foundational, lasting stability requires access to education, workforce pathways and supportive services. Our annual Fiesta events help generate critical support for this work.




